NTXCLC VISIT TO NEW HOLOCAUST MUSEUM

November 9th NTXCLC members Doug & Kathleen Ashby, Jim & Judy Hanson, Rubye Mae Musser, Steve & Debbie Overby, and Lenny & Judy Zimmerman toured the new, expanded Dallas Holocaust and Human Rights Museum in the West End of downtown Dallas. It is extraordinary! Several of us have been to the United States Holocaust Museum in Washington, D.C. Several other states have a Holocaust museum, but this museum is extra ordinary for it is one of its kind plus one in Illinois.

What makes the Dallas museum different is that it not only tells the Holocaust stories of the “major” countries of Germany, England, France, Poland, and Russia, it relates what was happening all over the world at the time. Holocaust, or “SHOAH”, is Hebrew for “catastrophic.” The museum tells the story of the Jewish people, from 2000 years of persecution and antisemitism, to the murder of six million Jews during the Holocaust. We learned of the atrocities perpetrated on the Jews during World War II by Hitler and Nazi Germany, and the acts of murder, savagery, and terror that the Jews endured during this period. Several exhibits include audio recordings of survivors, which dramatically bring the stories to life.

At the end of our tour, we were privileged to sit in a theater and “speak” with the holographic image of survivor Max Glauken. Max volunteered many hours of his time recording answers to over 1,500 questions, so that now, thanks to amazing new technology, when visitors ask him questions, it is as if he is there in person to answer them!

There is an inaugural special exhibition at the museum , “Stories of Survival, Object, Image, Memory”, that displays objects and prints of over 60 salvaged items – a family photo album, prayer book, teddy bear, and others – that victims brought with them on their harrowing journeys to America from Armenia, Bosnia, Cambodia, Iraq, Rwanda, South Sudan, Syria, and the Holocaust.

This museum is definitely worth seeing, but it is difficult to see everything in one visit. Allow at least 3 hours, and ask the guides to help you maximize your trip.

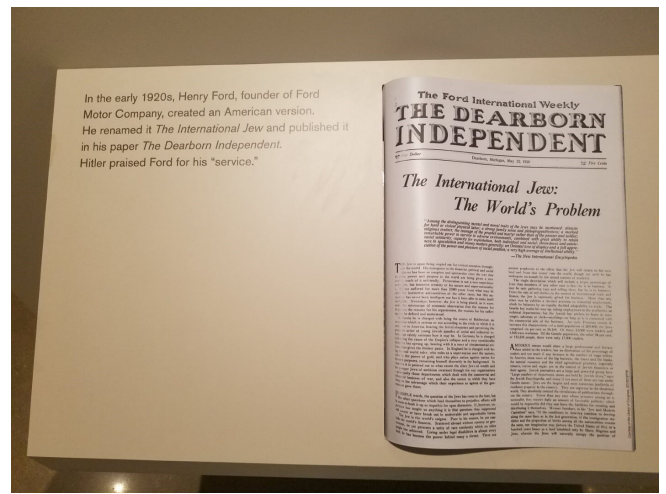
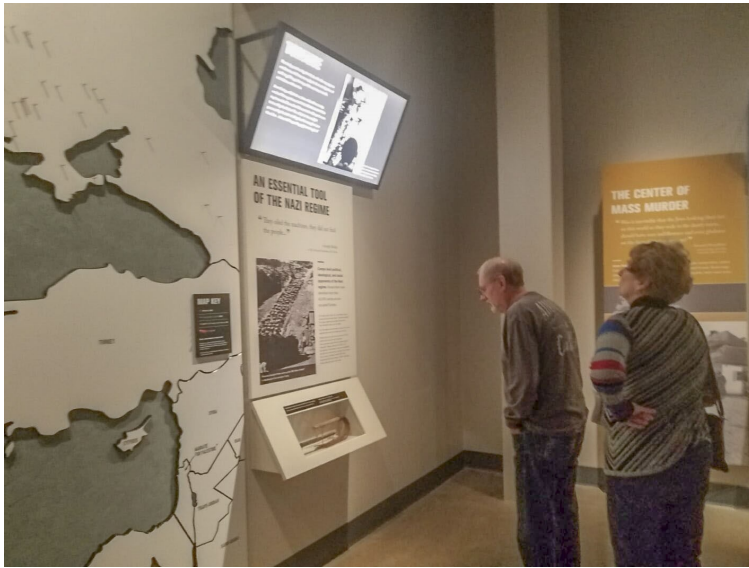

NTXCLC OFFICER ELECTIONS

Every year the regional clubs are required to elect or re-elect the officers of the club. According to the club's Constitution:

BOARD OF DIRECTORS: The Board of Directors of the Club shall consist of six (6) duly elected officers and four (4) directors, hereinafter referred to as "the Board." The Club officers shall consist of a President, Vice President, Treasurer, Secretary, Membership Chairman and Activities Director. The directors shall consist of the three (3) previous past presidents and the currently appointed representative to the Pate Swap Meet.

TERM OF OFFICE: The term of office for the Club officers shall be for one year and until their successors have been elected and installed.

ANNUAL MEETING: There will be at least one meeting of the Club's membership per calendar year for the purpose of electing the officers. Each Club member in good standing is entitled to one vote in the election.

Normally the election is held during our Regional Meet, but we need to modify in order to meet requirements.

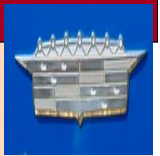
