A special guest was our Southwestern Regions VP, Tim Coy and Cynthia Rutledge from Colorado. It was great to have them representing the National CLC at our event.





On Friday morning, May 3rd, we left Lufkin and traveled to Nacogdoches, TX, to visit the Durst-Taylor Historic House and Gardens, made up of early original 1835 buildings and stories of the early people who settled in eastern Texas.

Then after a casual Mexican food lunch at Casa Tomas, we had a guided tour of Milliards Crossing Historic Village where we learned the village's story as the "oldest town in Texas". This site includes fifteen 19th century buildings that reveal how our pioneers lived in that period.







On Saturday, May 4th, we left our hotel to explore Lufkin and the "Pineywoods" region of Texas. We first visited and enjoyed a guided tour of the Naranjo Museum of Natural History, seeing mostly dinosaurs, and the work of Dr. Neal Naranjo, an archeologist who is still digging in Montana.



Afterwards we lunched at Ray's Drive In-Cafe, a very popular 1950's hamburger place in Lufkin.







The afternoon guided tour was at the Texas Forestry Museum. This museum is one of the largest of its kind in the U S. We saw and experienced the past, present, and future of trees: how they grow, are harvested, transported, processed, and their myriad uses in our daily life. This was truly interesting to a panhandle and farming girl who saw very few trees growing up. We saw a steam engine, a sawmill town

exhibit, logging train exhibit, a fire lookout tower, and of course, "Smokey Bear."







All 17 of us enjoyed our Saturday evening banquet at the Golden Corral. Especially the socializing and visiting with everyone. We all wish to thank Sue and Frank Kollar for the well-planned trip that was carried out to the finest degree by their co-members Ron and Karla Fratt.
