Annual Sweethearts and Orphans Car Show

Saturday, February 23, 2013 in Denton, Texas, it was the 14th Annual Sweethearts and Orphans car show; sweethearts in honor of Valentines Day, orphans because it was limited to "orphan" cars, those not made anymore. The meet was a three day event from Thursday evening until Sunday morning, and included a ride over to Decatur on Friday to visit the Decatur Auto Swap meet, which is getting larger and larger every year. The ladies had other activities that day, with tours around the Denton area. This meet is sponsored and put on by the North Texas Chapter of the Hudson-Essex-Terraplane Club and the Studebaker Drivers Club and the meet moves between Granbury, Denton and Weatherford, among other places.

The car show was on Saturday and attracted about 60 "orphan" cars, including about 11 Studebakers, a dozen Oldsmobiles of varying vintage, some Pontiacs, Triumphs (including a Triumph limo!), a 1928 Willys-Knight, several Nash cars, some Ramblers, a 1937 Peugeot, a Kaiser, about ten Hudsons, a couple of Corvairs, a Sears "motor carriage," one LaSalle, and more. I entered my '1939 LaSalle coupe because it is an "orphan," with LaSalles having not been made since 1940. The oldest car there was a running 1906 Sears motor Carriage (beautiful car!) and the newest was a 1982 Olds 442.

The meet benefits the American Heart Association since a heart is the symbol of Valentines Day. The show was a wonderful opportunity to see some very nice and very uncommon cars.

One prize was awarded per decade and I'm very pleased to tell you that my '39 LaSalle coupe won the award for the Thirties Decade. It was nice to represent our club and win a prize on my first time out with this group. I'd like to suggest that some of our other Lasalle owners consider this meet for next year, which will coincide with the weekend of the Decatur swap meet, and probably will be in Denton again.
