Lenora Rolla Heritage Center Museum Visit "The Test" - An exhibition about the Tuskegee Project and the Texas Airmen

On August 24<sup>th</sup> we had the once-in-lifetime opportunity to attend a reception honoring the servicemen connected with the flying Tusgegee Airmen " RED TAILS. " The NTXCLC had the privilege of being guests of the traveling exhibit at the Lenora Rolla Heritage Center Museum, Ft. Worth, Texas that runs through November. The history and pictures gave us a brief history of the struggles and final achievement of the TUSKEGEE Airmen that flew and displayed their talents finally in a vital assignment in some of the last battles of the war. The exhibit ---RED TAILS-----and "The TEST." We met one of the flight officers with the 477th Bombardment Group (B-25s), Dr. Robert T. McDaniel, who is a member of the Claude R. Platte D/FW Chapter of Tuskegee Airmen Inc. The exhibit depicting the history and speaks of the political and of the aerial battles that the first all black air wing endured during and after the war. "The Test," so the servicemen stated, was about their consistency and constant measure that they trained to until they finally managed to get an assignment that showed the world they could do it. We also had the honor of meeting Mrs. Erma Platte, wife of Captain Claude Platte, who signed his picture. Claude could not be there as he was admitted to the hospital today.

Outside in the small parking lot were member's Cadillacs for museum guests to look over. ### Under the Editor's Bonnet



I love the car ads that say, "1960's car, all original, seats, paint, engine, run good, always garaged. In storage last 30 years. Low mileage. \$xxx." So, what's wrong with this picture? Well, first of all, 50 years is a long time, and time,

more than mileage, kills mechanical objects that rely on rubber and plastic, along with vinyl, leather, and foam. Rubber hardens over time, especially seals and tires, and hoses, and tubes. Rubber engine seals with no lubrication, no driving, get hard and brittle and you then have a leak. Other rubber components get brittle and crumble. Plastic, foam, and vinyl looses its elasticity and becomes brittle and cracks or crumbles. Leather also hardens and could crack. An engine that has not been exercised may have rust inside, it may corrode in the jackets, and seize over time. Gear sets will corrode and rust and refuse to mesh.

So, if I bought this dusty jewel it would cost me for tires, a brake job—brake fluid attracts water, many other parts rust when idle, lots of new hoses, tubing, seals, a radiator and cooling system flush, a fuel system overhaul, new battery, new wipers, and wait—there is more. The interior may need it all. So my bargain, low mileage, original car is going to be expensive.

Instead, how about a 60's car that has been restored lately, overhauled, driven, shown, and loved? A little more money, but more car and fewer (some) worries. A better value if done right.
