

Texas Vietnam Heroes

On a beautiful balmy Saturday, January 24 our tour at the Cavanaugh Flight Museum, Addison, Texas, Honoring the Texas Vietnam Heroes Exhibit, was a superbouting. Thanks so much to Gerry Terranova for discovering it and suggesting we plan this for our January activity. All attending members enjoyed every minute of the 2 1/2 - hour special tour.

Retired Air Force Bill Wait, our very astute, knowledgeable, outstanding, well-versed tour director walked us through five hangers of aviation history, explaining the different planes used during the wars. He has flown some of the planes, and as a volunteer, and as a maintenance office has worked on them too. Mr. Wait worked at Bell Helicopter which had built some of viewed planes.

The Texas Vietnam Heroes touring exhibit personalized a tribute to the 3,417 Texans who died while serving in the US, Armed Forces. The exhibit included individual personalized dog tags embossed with the name, rank, branch of service, date of loss and home of record of each man. There are also black tags representing those Texans who are missing in action. Nearly one third of Texans killed in Vietnam died in 1968, with Houston having lost the most --356 citizens. A monument is to be installed on the northeast side of the Texas Capitol grounds in Austin during March 2014. The touring exhibit will travel to Corpus Christi and then be placed permanently in Austin.
