- 1. If you meet someone who owns a Cadillac or LaSalle car and you think this person would enjoy being a member of the North Texas Region Cadillac & LaSalle club, and also really enjoy being part of the National CLC club, get their email address (almost everyone has one today) and forward that to me. I can send them an application in an Adobe Pdf file that is the master for the paper ones we hand out. They can see all of the pictures, print out the form, and get their membership application and money to Bill H.
- 2. We have a new way for members to send money to either Bill Haesslein or Neil Jefferson (dues, parties, whatever). It is free, and you can use this to send money to anyone. It is called Square Cash. Here is how it works.
 - ♦ Draft an email with the recipient's email address in the "To" field.
 - ♦ Enter cash@square.com in the "Cc" field.
 - ♦ Enter at least \$1.00 in the subject line.
 - ♦ Add a note in the email body to inform the recipient why you are sending Cash.
 - ♦ Send the email.
 - If you haven't sent or received Square Cash before, the first time you do this you will be prompted to link a debit card. Once added, your cash will be sent and you'll see the "Cash Sent" confirmation screen.
 - ♦ To accept a payment, the recipient enters their debit card number once, and will automatically receive funds to their debit card thereafter.
 - Square Cash is free to send and receive, and there is no signup process. Funds are directly deposited into the recipient's bank account that is tied to their debit card, rather than held in a stored balance account.


