Why Region Members Must Also Pay National Dues

Each year National CLC sends each member an invoice for payment of the dues. This is separate from the dues paid for local Region membership. Each year we submit a roster of our local members to Columbus to compare and justify National membership.

Why? For one reason, this affords our club special insurance coverage if we are at 100% local and National membership and at a club-sponsored event. Here is an example of what may be covered. Can you imagine paying for this if not covered?



This coverage is for members when involved in a club sponsored event. If the club were not covered, it would be the member's expense and not the club's.


