John was educated at Penn State, University of DE, Altus Jr. College and Wharton School of Business. He was a successful businessman retiring as CFO of Republic Gypsum Co. in 1990. He opened ABBA Insurance Services, which he ran until 2015.

He met his bride as a cadet in the Civil Air Patrol, an auxiliary of the USAF. Together they volunteered as disaster response officers until his retirement as Lt. Col. in 1978. During his service to CAP he attended Officer Training, Flight Training and the War College, receiving many accommodations including Marksman, Legion of Honor, Humanitarian and Meritorious Service. John was a lifelong lover of dogs and was a member of the Quartz Mountain Kennel Club, Altus, OK. John was also a member of the Cadillac & LaSalle Club and enjoyed many of its activities.

He is preceded in death by his parents Kermit and Harriet, his wife Jacqueline, his brother Kip and his two sons Stephen and Michael. His daughter Stefani Mahlich, his brother Fredrick and sister Dorothea survive him. 


