NTXCLC OFFICER ELECTIONS

Every year the regional clubs are required to elect or re-elect the officers of the club. According to the club's Constitution:

BOARD OF DIRECTORS: The Board of Directors of the Club shall consist of six (6) duly elected officers and four (4) directors, hereinafter referred to as "the Board." The Club officers shall consist of a President, Vice President, Treasurer, Secretary, Membership Chairman and Activities Director. The directors shall consist of the three (3) previous past presidents and the currently appointed representative to the Pate Swap Meet.

TERM OF OFFICE: The term of office for the Club officers shall be for one year and until their successors have been elected and installed.

ANNUAL MEETING: There will be at least one meeting of the Club's membership per calendar year for the purpose of electing the officers. Each Club member in good standing is entitled to one vote in the election.

Normally the election is held during our Regional Meet, but we need to modify in order to meet requirements.

Below is the ballot for the elections. We will declare the required meeting at the tour of the new Holocaust Museum (page 9) and any late votes at the Toys-For Tots meet in December. Members also have the option of sending by email or snail mail their votes to the nominating committee.
