

CLC GRAND NATIONAL

This is a reminder that Online Registration for the 2020 Grand National is now available. You are encourage to use this facility, especially as there are a few spaces available on the very popular XT4 factory tour.

You can register by signing in to the CLC site and then clicking on Events. On the next screen select the line marked EVENT REGISTRATION first. Once you have completed the personal registration you can register a vehicle at the VEHICLE REGISTRATION link. There is also a link for those of you that are looking for Swap Meet or Car Corral spaces (VENDOR REGISTRATION). This link is the only one accessible to non-members.

When you start EVENT REGISTRATION you will notice some differences compared to last year. To help you out below are some tips and hints about the changes.

• There are instructions at the top of the page during the registration process, as well as extra text in relevant places in the online form. Please take the time to read those instructions.

• Due to some tours with limited availability, e.g. The XT4 Factory Tour, the site has a timer to prevent tour seats being held for too long. This timer sometimes obscures part of the text on your screen (depending on your computer hardware). If so, just click on the X at the top, right hand corner of the timer box, to make it disappear.

• A major change is that you no longer buy meal, tour, etc., tickets or merchandise for your group at one time. Instead, each attendee has their own list of selections.

• When you start the registration be sure to select the "1. General Member" and enter or confirm your details and selections. Once your own registration is complete, you can add other attendees by clicking on "Save & Add Another Attendee". You will then be given an opportunity to enter their details and their selection of extras. When all of your party has been added use Finalize to move to the confirmation and payment steps.

• This year's event only accepts credit cards for payment of online registrations. If you wish to pay via check, please submit a paper form with your check.

• Not every extra selection has a cost. When you selection a session, tour or meal it will show if there is a cost and you can select the relevant ticket. Some sessions only have a single ticket but you must still select it.

• If you need to add to or change your registration later, just go back the registration link. The site will recognize that you have already registered, select Modify This Registration and then click on the small pencil icon against the name of the attendee that needs a change or additional extras. You can also delete previously purchased items, but note that, unless they are replaced by extras of a equal; or greater value, any refund will be by check, not directly to your credit card.

• For VEHICLE REGISTRATION you will need a picture of your insurance certificate available on the computer and one of the Preservation Application Form, if applicable.
