**Seen in Car and Driver magazine in December,** Cadillac is ditching alphanumerics like CT4 and CT5 and committing to real model names like Eldorado and Escalade. The nomenclature change will begin in 2022, starting with Cadillac's first allelectric vehicle that's set to arrive that year. From then, the naming change will proceed on a rolling basis whenever new models are launched. Cadillac spokesperson Katie Minter told *C/D* that some of the names may draw from Cadillac's heritage, while others will be new. The Escalade is the only current Cadillac model with a real name rather than an alphanumeric.

### NTXCLC YEARLY SUMMARY

During the year we had many events shared by our active members. Beginning the year, we had our annual Christmas and Awards party at the Rolling Hills Country Club in Arlington, Texas. We installed our Board, and presented our new president and vice president.

In February the club visited the Old Red Museum of Dallas and ate dinner at the Spaghetti Warehouse in the West End district.

In March, as we are doing every month, the club has a First Saturday Breakfast Social get together. This is a holdover from the 1st Saturday breakfast after the Cars and Coffee meet that finally closed up. The breakfast has been very successful.

The club also visited the famous Leonard's Department Store in Ft. Worth in March. It was a most interesting visit.

April was a very busy month. First, we had our annual Pated Swap Meet Vendor Tile furbishing party where 10,000 rubber tiles were sorted, arranged, replaced, and banded. The purpose is to inspect each vendor's space-marking tile and each of 42 tile tubs. Each tub has a laminated map of the zone and the blocks assigned for that tub. We place the tiles in the correct tub, in numerical order by blocks (even numbers in one stack and odd numbers in s second stack). Each stack gets a big rubber band to secure it. Missing tiles or unreadable tiles are replaced, using the vinyl film from the roll to make the replacement tile.

A week later it was time to lay out the tiles into the vendor spaces at the Texas Motor Speedway in preparation for the Pate Swap Meet, the second largest swap meet in the country. This process takes all day on the Saturday before the meet, and then some further days in the next week, setting out street signs and checking on missing tiles.

During the actual swap meet NTXCLC maintained a hospitality tent where it promoted the club and welcomed members and friends. When the swap meets ended, we were tasked to retrieve all the vendor space marking tiles and street signs and put them in storage.

In May the club enjoyed a three-day visit to Lufkin and Nacogdoches, Texas and met with the members of the Gulf Coast Region for an Inter-regional Meet and Driving Tour, and annual event for both clubs.

The big June event was participation in the CLC Grand National in Louisville, KY. EacH GN gets better every year.

The month of July included a road trip and social gathering in the Weatherford area, west of Ft. Worth.

August and September were planned but due to the extreme hot weather, we just had social meetings and Board meetings.

But October was special. We did a lake boat ride aboard the Harbor Lights in the evening on Lake Ray Hubbard and all members had a great time. We had a beautiful sunset and a harvest moon rising. Another event was the Gateway Classic Car Tour in Grapevine Texas. One hundred and seventy cars were featured.

In November the club visited the very new and extremely popular Dallas Holocaust and Human Rights Museum in downtown Dallas. This is a must-see museum, located right near the 6<sup>th</sup> Floor museum and the Dealey Plaza where President John F. Kennedy was assassinated.

December the club again did its Toys for Tots at the Frank Kent Cadillac dealership in west Ft. Worth. Cadillac trunks were filled with new toys and the event, done for many years, was a success. Sadly, the man who helped start this location's program, Randoll Reagan, a former U.S. Marine, passed away this year.

And we had quarterly Board meetings, monthly newsletters, and impromptu meetings at local car shows.
